About Coreso

1 Description

The Regulatory Advisor reports to the CEO of Coreso as well as closely collaborates with the Department Managers (Chief Operations Officer, Head of Development and Chief Information Officer).

- Build and maintain knowledge of expected and ongoing legislative and regulatory reforms on the European level.

 - o Follow the ongoing negotiations on topics with connections to Coreso main missions.
- Support the management team with analyses and decision proposals on strategic topics.
 - o Draw up technical reports.
 - o Prepare position papers, press reviews and press releases.
 - o Contribute to the definition of internal/external communication strategy.
- Develop the action plan to be implemented to comply with the European legal and regulatory environment and ensure its implementation.
 - o Support the internal/external communication strategy (including Web strategy).
 - o Disseminate knowledge within the company.
 - o Represent the company during meetings and workshops.
 - o Schedule and coordinate meetings, seminars and visits at the Coreso headquarters.
- Closely cooperate with Coreso shareholders Public Affairs Departments.

2 Content

- Identify the main lines of development of European regulations which will impact Coreso activities.
- Analyse and manage risks and opportunities.
- Inform each Department of the company about the content of ongoing European regulation developments.
- Devise the action plan to be implemented within the Company.
- Manage the implementation of the action plan by contributing to the development of strategic points or by assisting and guiding the internal process owners.
- Ensure continuous monitoring of legislative and regulatory framework.
- Contribute to the coordination of contributions of Coreso to ENTSO-E and Regional Steering Bodies and disseminate information within the Company.
